

## About the Author

Dr. Charles V. Tramont received his Bachelor of Science degree from John Carroll University in Cleveland and his M.D. from New York Medical College in New York City. After completing his residency at St. Ann Hospital, a private OB/GYN hospital in Cleveland, Ohio, he served two years on active duty in the Air Force during the Vietnam War.
